Summary:

ARTE aims to establish a network among five cities—Mola di Bari (Italy), Shkodër (Albania), Guimarães (Portugal), Tuzi (Montenegro), and Thessaloniki (Greece)—to promote joint cultural initiatives, sustainable cooperation, and knowledge exchange.

The project's main objective is to increase young people's participation in the social, cultural, and economic life of the European Union by enabling them to express their vision of Europe through art, while bringing together people living in EU Member States and candidate countries through the following activities:

- **Online training sessions** for young people (aged 18–30) in all partner countries, providing information on the history of the European Union, opportunities for employment, education, personal and professional development, mobility, and future prospects for young people in the EU.
- **Local artistic workshops** in each partner country, where young people will express their vision of Europe and their expectations as current or future European citizens through various forms of art, such as songs, paintings, sculptures, drawings, dance, musical performances, and other artistic expressions.
- **International events** in Italy, Portugal, and Albania to showcase the artistic works created during the workshops, share young people's experiences, and provide opportunities for citizens, invited guests, and international experts to gain a better understanding of the history and policies of the European Union, discuss EU membership and the role of Europe, and strengthen social and political cohesion.
